Comments about the Readings for the 5 Weekends of Lent:

1st Sunday of Lent:

Mt. 4:1-11 Temptation of Jesus – Devil trying to have Jesus be seen as something other than the Father has planned

Genesis 2:7 – 3:7 Temptation and Fall of Adam and Eve

Romans 5:12-19 Through one man, sin entered the world; through one man the grace of God made all righteous

2nd Sunday of Lent:

Mt. 7:1 – 9 The Transfiguration – the 3 Apostles are shown the glory of Jesus, Moses and Elijah

Genesis 12:1 – 4 Abram told to go forth to a land that I will show you.

3rd Sunday of Lent:

John 4:5 – 42 The Woman at the Well – meeting Jesus, the woman gradually gains insight and sees Jesus as the long expected Messiah

4th Sunday of Lent:

John 9:1 – 41 Cure of Man Born Blind – the man gains his sight and also receives insight into who Jesus is

Ephesians 5:8 – 14 “Once you were in darkness, but now you are in light

I Samuel “See as God sees and not as man sees...”

5th Sunday of Lent:

John 11:1 – 45 Raising of Lazarus from the Dead – those gathered, seeing what Jesus did, they came to believe in him

Perhaps we can find a simple phrase that we can use throughout Lent that will reflect the vision of these readings – perhaps something around “sight and insight”
